Understanding the World

In Science the children will be conducting an experiment to see what floats and what sinks.

In History we will be looking at how modes of transport such as planes and trains have changed over time.

In R.E., we will be learning about special stories from around the world.

In ICT, we will continue to navigate and complete simple programs.

Communication & Language

We will be listening to stories and answering simple questions about them. We will be asking the children to infer about stories, (talk about what they can't see and what they think) and what they think might happen next. In our vocabulary sessions, we will be focusing on positional language, the garden, the seaside, opposites and transport.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We will be learning about how to care for ourselves and others. We will be learning about how we can overcome challenges with resilience and perseverance.



The children will be consolidating their knowledge of addition and subtraction and finding the answer to simple additions and subtractions using a range of methods (using objects, Numicon, drawing and using a number line). They will also be measuring the length and height of objects using non-standard measurements, such as cubes, comparing heights and lengths.

Expressive Arts & Design

We will be creating seal life pictures using paint and oil pastels. We will be designing and baking fish shaped cookies..

We will be learning different songs linked to our topic and adding instruments to match.

English
