How can Parents Help?

Parents, you can help children by looking through your child's knowledge organisers with them (handed out at the start of each half term). Geography is all around us! When you are out around town, notice things that are happening. Talk about how places are changing and why they might be changing. When you are travelling to places, talk about where you are going and look at the sign posts together. If you are looking at a map, encourage the children to look with you and try to follow a route.

On holidays or days out, discuss how the places you visit are similar to places at home.

Encourage the children to question and to find out the answers in different ways. Try to make use of the library in town or visits to places of interest in the local area.
