CURRICULUM TOPIC WEB FOR PARENTS

Science

- To discuss the developmental differences between babies, toddlers, children and adults.
- To draw and label parts of the body including senses.

Music

- Make sounds in different ways including hitting, blowing and shaking.
- Keeping a beat using body parts e.g. stamping, clapping etc.

Maths

- Count in different multiples including twos, fives and 10.
- Recognise read and write numbers 1 to 10 in numerals and words.
- To understand 1 more and 1 less and use these to solve simple problems.

Computing

- To learn key information about computers and how to access them.
- To practice basic computer skills.
- To learn how to use technology safely and respectfully.

- Explore sacred writings, & talk about their meanings

- Talk about the things they remember about being a baby.
- Write a sequence of connected events in an appropriate order.

PE

- To learn to catch and throw a ball correctly.
- To serve with the correct technique and return with control.
- To travel around with different parts of the body.
- To balance with control.
