# Geography Enrichment

In addition to this, quality resources are used and real-life experiences are planned on a regular basis to enrich children and create cultural capital. For example, every class has a set of globes and atlases. We also have maps, rain gauges and compasses. We ensure that all children take part in at least two Geography field trips per year. These include, visits to Hollingworth Lake, developing map skills in the local area, orienteering, visiting local rivers, Autumn walks, recording the weather and rain fall, residential visits to Robinwood, analysing local rock types and visits to local towns and cities, etc.
