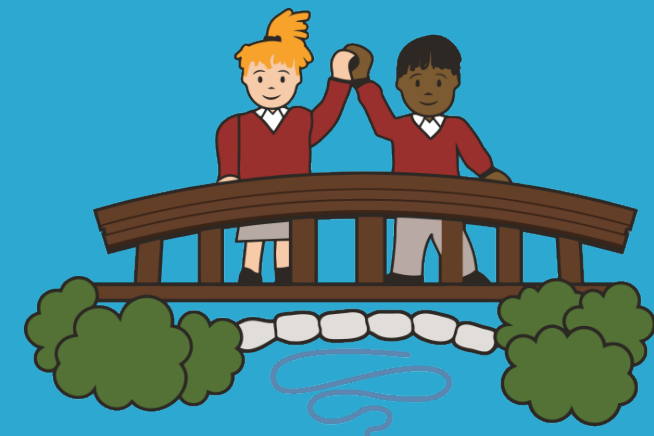

## Science Enrichment

At Kentmere Academy we have at least one educational trip, visitors or 'wow' days for every topic, every half term. When possible, these are linked with Science.

Visitors have included a geologist for year 3/4 pupils. The pupils were taken on a journey looking at rock formation, how the earth began and the journey of rocks in the Pennine Hills. Years 5/6 pupils visited Eureka and learnt about the human body. And year 1/2 pupils learnt all about dinosaurs, pre-historic times and fossils. Pupils love these visits and it makes their learning come to life.

Throughout the year we provide opportunities for children to participate in Science learning outside the National curriculum. Science After School Club runs all year for KS1 and KS2, we have the travelling Science show who visits once a year and other initiatives such as British Science Week, The Big Bug Hunt and the Big Garden Birdwatch.
