To read a variety of stories Kippers New Pet, the role of a Vet, Chinese New Year.
To talk about characters and main story settings.
To write own name.
To write using clearly identifiable letters to communicate meaning.
To begin to write labels.
To write initial and final sounds.
To recognise sounds – take part in daily phonic sessions

Expressive Arts & Design

To sing songs related to pets, vets and Chinese New year,
To explore colour and how colours can be changed.
To paint pictures animals and dragons.
To act out different roles in the house, vets, and Chinese restaurant.
To join in with moving bodies to music-being different pets and dragon dancing
To experiment with musical instruments

Physical Development

To use a variety of indoor and outdoor resources
To take off and put on jumpers independently.
To move in a variety of ways- fast/slow, small/big etc
dragon-large and small movements.
To understand the effects of our bodies after exercise.
To develop fine motor control-funky fingers
