Soaring to success

Spanish Lower Key Stage 2

In Y3/4, children begin their Spanish lessons, which are taught discretely and progressively, to begin with basics.

Children are taught:

- Know where Spain is
- Know the culture of Spain and typical Spanish cuisine
- Know articles such as 'a' 'the' 'an'
- The pronunciations of key Spanish phonetics, such as 'j' 'll' 'h' 'c'
- Develop understanding of the sounds of individual letters and groups of letters (phonics)
- To know the emphasis on words in Spanish are pronounced on the second to last vowel sound
- Know at least 10 correct names of fruit
- Know at least 10 correct names for vegetables
- Know the days of the week
- Know at least 10 colours
- Know numbers 0-100
- Know all months in a year
- Know key greetings and responses
- At least 10 animal names
- Know and use classroom commands
- Know family names and know how to describe age
- Know items in the classroom
- Know simple greetings (e.g. saying hello and goodbye, saying how they are)
- Know at least 10 verbs to describe hobbies and interests
- Understand the concept of gender (masculine, feminine, neuter (if applicable) and which article (definite or indefinite) to use correctly with different nouns
- Introduce and use the negative form
- Begin to look at what a fully conjugated verb looks like
