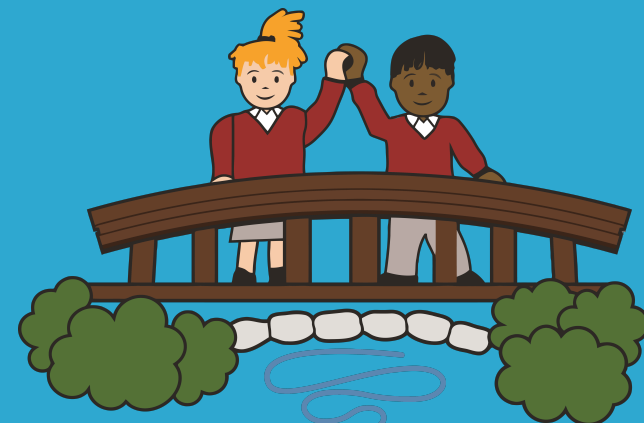

Computing Lower Key Stage 2

In Year 3/4, pupils will build on their knowledge from Key Stage One and develop their understanding of designing, writing and debugging programs. There is a greater emphasis on reasoning and decomposing problems into smaller parts. They are beginning to use sequence, selection and repetition in their work which will be developed further in Year 5/6. They are building their Information Technology skills and can use a variety of different programs, as well as aspects within programs, across a range of devices. The pupils build on their understanding of the SMART rules for Online Safety. They learn about developing secure passwords, age restrictions and assessing the reliability of sources.
