Soaring to success

Maths Key Stage 1

Throughout **Key Stage 1**, we follow the National Curriculum using the mastery approach and use the Maths No Problem textbooks to support this. Our Mathematics curriculum will provide many opportunities for children to develop confidence and fluency with whole numbers, counting and place value. The use of practical equipment, such as concrete objects and measuring tools, will support the children to gain a deeper conceptual understanding before being challenged through tasks and questions to explain their reasoning and solve a range of problems. The children are equipped with the skills to recognise shapes and their properties and measures to describe and compare different quantities such as length, mass, capacity/volume, time and money.

In addition to daily Mathematics lessons, children take part in a Maths basic skills session. Fluency and accuracy of key mathematics skills are developed during these sessions and provide an opportunity to revisit and review misconceptions and deepen previously taught content.
