

Understanding the World

In Science, we will be learning about the functions of the human body. We will learn about how to keep ourselves and our bodies healthy.

In R.E., we will be talking about belonging to the class and school. We will talk about our families and the people who are special to us. We will also be learning about the celebration of 'Harvest'.

In History we will be learning about the concept of change and discussing how we have changed since birth.

In Geography we will explore our local environment and learn about where we live.

Maths

We will be learning about number and patterns including shape, space and measure. We will be looking at sorting items, creating and finishing patterns and exploring shapes.

English

We will be reading books about bears such as 'Brown Bear' and 'Goldilocks'. We will listen carefully and begin to write the sounds we can hear in words.

In phonics, we will be learning the sounds of each letter. We will be practising our fine motor and handwriting skills to write the sounds we can hear in words.

Communication & Language

We will be listening to stories and answering simple questions about them. We will be answering who? What? and where? questions and talking about the things we like and dislike. The adults in the class will be supporting us to speak in full sentences and will remind us to use our manners throughout the day.
